

Photograph Submission Cuidelines	
Photograph Submission Guidelines Each project must have a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 12 photographs. At least one photograph must be vertical.	
At reast one photograph must be vertical. You will need to submit a copy of your photos with an approximate size of 1200 x 1800 pixels at 300 dpi. (Please note that submissions of low resolution photos are no longer required). Change the file names on your photos to follow the sequence of your project description. For example, name your files - photo01 jpg, photo02 jpg, photo03 jpg, etc	
Eliminate any company identification from photos or they will be disqualified. Photos may not be altered to enhance finished product beyond adjustments to contrast and brightness. Photos may be submitted by the due date in one of two ways.	
On a CD or flash drive mailed to the ILCA Headquarters. Write your company name and the project name on the face of the CD or flash drive. Files must be jpeg only.	
Upload your photos to Dropbox and email a link to <u>information@lica.net</u> . Sign up for a free account at <u>https://www.dropbox.com/</u> .	
Upload your photos into a folder with your company name and project name on it. Highlight your folder and click 'Share link'. Add <u>information@ilca.net</u> in the recipient box and write your company name and project name in the message box. Click 'Send'.	
Submission of this application releases copyright of any and all copyrighted photographs. These photos will not be distributed by the ILCA outside of ILCA and will only be used by the ILCA for promotional and educational purposes and/or in any printed and digital ILCA publications.
